Reserves up by \$27m

KARACHI: The country's total liquid foreign exchange reserves slightly increased by \$27 million to \$15.605 billion end of the last week.

During the week ending 17th August 2019, the State Bank of Pakistan's reserves decreased by \$26 million to \$8.239 billion, due to external debt servicing and other official payments. However, reserves held by banks mounted up \$53 million to \$7.366 billion end of the last week up from \$7.313 billion a week earlier.
