

'Certain trade issues still unresolved'

LAHORE: Sri Lanka and Pakistan have signed free trade agreement (FTA), but certain issues are pending resolution, a diplomat said on Monday.

Sri Lankan High Commissioner Noordeen Mohamed Shaheid expressed the hope that the amended agreement would be beneficial for the two countries. Speaking at the LCCI, he said there is a vast scope for the expansion of two-way trade between Pakistan and Sri Lanka.
