



Dawood terms budget pro-business

ISLAMABAD: :Adviser to Prime Minister on Commerce, Textiles and Industries Abdul Razak Dawood on Tuesday said despite many challenges on economic fronts, the government had announced pro-business and people-friendly budget.

Talking to media outside the Parliament House, he said, the budget would boost the local industry and duties proposed on imported items would also encourage local manufactured products.
