- Exports are exempt from Sales Tax around the World.
- Decision of withdrawal of SRO 1125 abolishing the Zero Rated Regime would prove detrimental for Value Added Export sectors of Pakistan.
- The Federal Government has already pending refunds to clear worth PKR 200 (B) of the Exporters.
- Export Sector of Pakistan especially the SME based Exporters of Sialkot are facing severe liquidity issues due to pendency of Sales Tax Refunds and withdrawal of such facility would block the Working Capital of these firms which could result in closure of Factories.
- This decision would lead to massive unemployment of skilled work force.
- The Export Sector of Sialkot is contributing USD 2.5 (B) to the National Exchequer through its sectors including Surgical Instruments, Leather Products and Sports Goods & Wear which are exported 100% to the world.
