

Reserves down

KARACHI: Reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan declined by \$203 million to \$7.6 billion during the week ended on June 19.

The decrease in dollar stocks came amid external debt servicing and other official payments.

Meanwhile, holdings of commercial banks amounted to \$7.03bn whereas total liquid reserves of the country stood at \$14.64bn during the period under review.
