

Economic policies, PTI govt takes allies into confidence

ISLAMABAD: Prime Minister Imran Khan took the PTI and allied parties' members of Parliament into confidence on economic policies while chairing a meeting on Monday and said that the government is aware of the people's problems.

The PM directed the parliamentarians to address the problems of the people in their respective constituencies. The Prime Minister also informed the parliamentarians about the proposed asset declaration scheme. The Prime Minister said solid steps would be taken for bringing improvement in the economic conditions of the country, saying the interests of the country are far more important than those of political policies. He said national interests and people's rights will be protected at all costs. The PTI will be fulfilling the commitment of reforms it made with the people, he said.

The Prime Minister also took the parliamentarians into confidence on government's economic reforms ahead of the budget. The party parliamentarians and members of allied parties assured full support to the Prime Minister.

Separately, Minister of State for Revenue Hammad Azhar stated at a private TV channel that salient features of proposed asset declaration scheme have been shared with the parliamentarians and they will be taken to the federal cabinet for consideration and approval today (Tuesday).
