



Moon-sighting mobile App forwarded to CII: Fawad

Federal Minister for Science and Technology Fawad Chaudhry has said that his ministry has prepared lunar calendar and the moon-sighting App. In his message here on Monday, Fawad Chaudhry said, "Lunar calendar and moon-sighting mobile App have been forwarded to Council of Islamic Ideology (CII)." He also urged the CII to brief Chairman Ruet-e-Hilal Committee Mufti Munib-ur-Rehman, Shahab-din-Popalzai and other religious scholars over it.

The minister said Council of Islamic Ideology will convene a meeting, where officials of Ministry of Science and Technology will give a briefing after that the matter will be forwarded to the federal cabinet. He said, "We will move ahead as per the decision of the cabinet over the matter."
