

Reserves up by \$82 million to \$14.885 billion

The country's total liquid foreign reserves increased by \$82 million during the last week. According to State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), the total liquid foreign exchange reserves held by the country stood at \$14.885 billion as on 1 February 2019 compared to \$14.803 billion as on 25 January 2019.

During the week under review, the SBP reserves increased by \$38 million to \$8.193 billion up from \$8.154 billion. Similarly, reserves held by the banks also surged by \$44.4 million to \$6.693 billion end of last week.
