



PBIF slams hike in gas, power POL prices

KARACHI: President Pakistan Businessmen and Intellectuals Forum (PBIF), Mian Zahid Hussain has said that government's steps to provide relief to the masses are laudable but a continued hike in power, gas and POL prices hitting poor people and the businesses.
