

PM lauds LCCI export-boost plan

LAHORE: The government wants to see the businesses growing, making profits, and creating wealth, as a nation cannot prosper without creation of wealth, a statement quoted Prime Minister Imran Khan as saying on Wednesday.

“The year 2020 will be the year of progress and prosperity and it’s our need that business community flourishes...,” said a Lahore Chamber of Commerce and Industry’s (LCCI) release quoting the premier, who it said was in a meeting with their delegation that presented him with a roadmap to improve exports.

The document highlights the potential of various sectors of economy with proposals/execution to achieve the target of export-led growth, the chamber said adding that Prime Minister appreciated the LCCI plan and its supportive measures aimed at economic sustainability of the country.
