

SBP's forex reserves up \$184m

KARACHI: The State Bank's reserves increased by \$184 million to reach \$12 billion mark during the last week.

According to weekly foreign exchange report issued by SBP on Thursday, SBP's foreign exchange reserves rose to \$11.915 billion during last week ending January 24, 2020 compared to \$11.732 billion on January 17, 2020.

During the period under review, reserves held by banks decreased by \$92 million to \$6.448 billion. In addition, the total liquid foreign exchange reserves held by the country stood at \$18.363 billion, up by \$92 million during last week.
