

NEPRA panel to probe Karachi outages

KE blames federal govt for excessive load-shedding

National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (Nepra) has decided to form a four-member professionals/experts committee to visit Karachi, conduct on-ground investigations and submit a detailed report into power load-shedding before the end of next week.

The committee would be headed by the Director

General (Monitoring and Enforcement) and Nepra would take further necessary action on the basis of the report, said a press release issued on Friday.

Meanwhile, K-Electric (KE) has held the federal government responsible for prolonged power outages in the country's biggest city, claiming that the government was not providing it with the required quantity of oil and gas.
