

New SOPs issued for govt offices

KARACHI. A new set of standard operating procedures (SOPs) for employees working at the Sindh government's offices was issued by the provincial government on Friday. In a notification, Sindh chief secretary Syed Mumtaz Ali Shah stated that the government would limit the number of employees present at the offices by implementing a 15-day rotation, with each employee working from home for half the month. Employees suffering from long-term illnesses, however, will work from home for the entire month, while employees infected with Covid-19 and seeking leave for isolation must present medical reports with their coronavirus diagnosis.
