

More industries to be allowed to operate as situation improves: CM

LAHORE: Punjab government has allowed some industries to operate but the observance of SOPs has been declared mandatory and more industries will be allowed to start their operations as the situation is improved.

Punjab Chief Minister Sardar Usman Buzdar said this while talking to Chairman Faisalabad Industrial Estate Development and Management Company (FIEDMC) who presented a cheque of Rs four million for CM Fund for Corona control on behalf of industrialists of Faisalabad today. He also presented a donation of N95 and surgical masks, PPEs, disinfection material and other equipment amounting to Rs3.5 million on behalf of two Chinese companies Time Ceramics and Henan DR.

The CM directed to accelerate the speed of work on Allama Iqbal Industrial City as it is the flagship project of CPEC.
