

TDAP holds webinar on trade laws

KARACHI. The Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP), in coordination with Trade and Investment Wing of High Commission of Pakistan in Nigeria, organised a webinar on regulatory framework of Nigeria on October 29, which was attended by more than 120 businessmen from leading business houses, associations and chambers of Pakistan. Speakers highlighted the regulatory and legal framework of Nigeria and the potential of Africa region. They also apprised the participants about the steps being taken by respective ministries and departments for increasing exports. They further added that Nigeria is a big market in Africa with \$47 billion annual import. Pakistan's share in Nigeria's import is not significant and through collective efforts and by removing barriers, exports can be increased.
