

## The only solution to prevent Corona is to follow certain SOPs

The second wave of COVID-19 across the country has led to a huge increase in cases in Sindh province, especially in urban areas. All the management of offices, factories, shops, restaurants, hotels, manufacturing units and other workplaces should ensure compliance with SOPs. Those who do not act, strict disciplinary action will be taken against them.



- Make mask mandatory for staff & customers. Those who don't wear masks should not be allowed to enter the institutions.
- Make sure to arrange disinfectant sanitizers for washing hands in institutions.
- Use sanitizer frequently, prefer to wash your hands with soap for at least 20 seconds.
- Institutes should make sanitizing gates on entry and exit points and also make the arrangements of washing or sanitizing booth in possible areas of the institution
- The management shall provide thermal guns to the staff present on the entry gate. To make sure the other staff to get in after their screening.
- High fever, flu or symptoms like flu and cough should not be permitted to enter in the institution.
- \* The management of industrial units/business organization should ensure the presence of Doctors and other trained medical staff for screening of all workers.
- Maintain proper ventilation in offices and other work places.
- Brief in detail about COVID-19 and its spread to the staff. Posters or banners on corona symptoms, precautions and treatment should be displayed prominently in the institution.

- Avoid shaking hands, hugging during professional meetings. For greetings fold your hands together or put your right hand towards your left side of chest.
- Make sure all work places maintain a specified distance between staff during work.
- All public and private offices should adopt 50% staff "work from home" policy.
- No institution will hire an employee or a labourer over 55 years of age.
- Step wise schedule and queuing method should be adopted to avoid rushing on duty, break or on the time of off.
- Make sure to wipe clean with proper disinfectant items touched by workers or customers such as door's handle, printers, remote, switches, telephone, keyboards and other various machinery/equipments on daily basis.
- Do not throw factory waste in the open areas, it should be disposed properly.
- Timing for business/markets will be 06:00am to 08:00pm and will remain closed in the weekend other than essential service providers.
- \* To ensure the SOPs issued by the Government, Commissioners, deputy Commissioners, SSPs and recognized personnel of Labour & Industries Department will periodically check vehicles on the road, in the case of violation legal action will be taken on the spot.
