

PM to visit Malaysia from 20th

ISLAMABAD: Prime Minister Imran Khan will visit Malaysia along with a high-level delegation on November 20-21.

This would be the first state visit by any foreign leader since Dr Mahathir Mohamad assumed office in May 2018 and Prime Minister Imran Khan's first bilateral visit to Malaysia, according to a statement issued by Foreign Office on Thursday. The two prime ministers will have a tête-à-tête, followed by delegation-level talks.

Pakistan and Malaysia enjoy warm brotherly relations founded in mutual respect, friendship and understanding reinforced by strong cultural and religious affinities.

The visit of the Prime Minister would provide an opportunity to further cement the existing friendly and cordial bilateral relations by enhancing economic, trade and commercial ties for mutual benefit.
