

KCCI's top three posts may go to BMG-backed candidates

KARACHI: Junaid Ismail Makda, Khurram Shehzad and Asif Shaikh Javed are likely to be elected as president, senior vice president and vice president of Karachi Chamber of Commerce and Industry, for 2018-19, respectively.
