

NKATI's plea to Sindh governor, CM

KARACHI: North Karachi Association of Trade and Industry (NKATI)) members have sought the intervention of Sindh Governor and caretaker chief Minster to direct K-electric to immediately restore power of industrial area as the load-shedding would cause irreparable loss to economy

This demand was made during an emergency meeting held to discuss the load-shedding issue. Meeting pointed out that power outage has been reached up to 6 hours from 12.30 midnight to 6.30 am which resulted closure of one shift. Industrialists expressed fear of losing their hard earned export markets to competitor countries. They said this should be the eye-opener and government should not create unemployment by allowing K-electric to carry out long hours load shedding in this industrial area. The meeting was chaired by NKATI patron-in-chief A Moiz Khan and president Shahid Sabir.
