M RAFIQUE GORAYA LAHORE: 21st June (today) is the longest day in Pakistan with 15.06 hours day light. The Sun rises at 04.56 hours and sets 07.12 p.m. on this day. It may be added that June Solstice: is the Longest and Shortest Day of the Year. The June solstice is the summer solstice in the Northern Hemisphere and the winter solstice in the Southern Hemisphere. The date varies between June 20 and June 22, depending the and the local time on year, zone. (A solstice is an event occurring when the Sun appears to reach its most northerly or southerly excursion relative to the celestial equator on the celestial sphere. Two solstices around June 21 and December occur annually, Astronomers say that, the summer solstice occurs when the sun is directly over the Tropic of Cancer, or 23.5° north latitude. This will occur at exactly 6:07 am Eastern time on Thursday the 21st June. March and September, Earth's Northern Hemisphere gets more exposure to direct sunlight over the course of a day.
