FPCI's BMP says concerned at rupee slide

LAHORE: The FPCI Businessmen Panel (BMP) has said that the unstable rupee value and its massive fall continued to damage the economy, as the local currency has hit a new all-time low mark against US dollar in the interbank market amidst rising energy cost and escalating markup rate owing to tough conditions of the International Monetary Fund, devaluing the rupee by 1.96% or Rs3.82 against the US dollar in the inter-bank market.

Weekly Cotton Review: Spot rate up as cotton prices continue to rise

KARACHI: Cotton prices continued to rise during previous week. There was an increase in spot rate by Rs.300 per maund. The production of cotton was twenty lac and fifteen thousand bales. Up to August 31, the production is expected to be 12.6 lac bales, 82% more than the same period of last year which was about 28 lac bales.

Restructuring domestic debt

Domestic Debt Restructuring (DDR) is necessary and viable.
