Pakistan, China sign \$4.5bn farm deals, boosting jobs and food supply

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan and China have signed 79 investment agreements worth about \$4.5 billion in agriculture and food-related businesses, marking one of the largest foreign investment commitments in Pakistan's farm sector and raising hopes for jobs, modern farming and cheaper food.

Gulf investors launch \$2bn arbitration case against Pakistan over KE dispute

ISLAMABAD: In a shocking development, Saudi and Kuwaiti investors in K-Electric have launched a USD2 billion international arbitration case against Pakistan, escalating a years-long dispute over regulatory intervention, unpaid government dues and the prolonged blocking of a USD1.77 billion sale of the country's largest private power utility.

US envoy says bilateral trade to cross \$8bn

ISLAMABAD/LAHORE: US Chargé d'Affaires to Pakistan Natalie A. Baker has underscored the depth of bilateral commercial relationship, highlighting the growing momentum in trade ties between the two countries. "Expanding trade reflects a strong foundation that highlights the positive impact of US economic engagement in Pakistan and globally.

Pakistan plans return to global bond market after four years

Pakistan plans to return to the global bond market after four years, underscoring its progress in economic stabilisation after coming close to a default just a few years ago, reports Bloomberg. The South Asian nation will issue a proposal for advisers in the coming weeks, said Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb.

Foreign firms repatriate \$1.558bn in 1HFY26

KARACHI: Multinational companies repatriated \$1.558 billion in profits and dividends in the first six months of the current fiscal year, a 27.18 per cent increase compared to the same period last year, according to the figure from the State Bank of Pakistan on Tuesday.

Industry leaders warn Rs131bn power cross-subsidy is undermining competitiveness

KARACHI/LAHORE: Leading industrial bodies have criticised the government's policy of funding electricity subsidies for lifeline consumers through higher industrial tariffs, warning that extracting Rs131 billion from industry is damaging competitiveness, accelerating factory closures and threatening economic stability.

Pakistan, UK discuss \$400m minerals cooperation, expand energy sector ties

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan and the United Kingdom have explored a potential \$400 million collaboration in the minerals sector, alongside expanded cooperation in oil and gas exploration and offshore energy, as Islamabad steps up efforts to attract foreign investment and strengthen sector governance.
