Monetary policy today

KARACHI: The State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) is set to announce its monetary policy for the next 50 days today (Monday), with market participants widely expecting the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) to keep the policy rate unchanged.

Govt urged to set up GSP+ coordination mechanism
