Rising global oil prices pose serious risks to economic recovery: BMP

CTO Islamabad refuses to follow FTO's order

Weekly Cotton Review: Price stability continues as trading stays slow

KARACHI: The domestic cotton market is currently maintaining a trend of price stability, however stocks remain limited and overall trading activity continues to be sluggish. The latest figures regarding textile exports are deeply alarming.

Marginal gains

KARACHI: The Pakistani rupee continued to post marginal gains against the US dollar, appreciating 0.03 percent or Re0.09 in the inter-bank market during the previous week. The local unit closed at 279.31, against 279.40 it had closed the week earlier against the greenback, according to the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP).

ISLAMABAD: The federal government on Sunday announced public holidays on the occasion of the upcoming Eid-ul-Fitr. According to a notification issued by the Cabinet Division of Pakistan, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif has declared March 20 and March 21 (Friday and Saturday) as public holidays for government offices observing both five- and six-day working weeks.

'Poor man's fuel' becomes the most expensive

ISLAMABAD: The government has increased the price of kerosene oil by Rs40 per litre and approved Rs23 billion in price differential subsidy for payments to oil marketing companies (OMCs) to keep the prices of two other products — petrol and high-speed diesel (HSD) — unchanged for the week ending March 20.

Domestic cotton prices up as imports suspended due to war
