FBR receives 4.821m tax returns up to Oct 26th

ISLAMABAD: The FBR has received 4.821 million income tax returns for Tax Year 2024 up to October 26 against 2.407 million returns filed during the same period of 2023. According to the FBR's latest data of return filing, out of 4.821 million income tax returns filed for TY 2024, 1.820 million returns filed nil-income. There was zero tax deposited with these nil-returns.

KARACHI: The local gold prices saw a big recovery on Saturday, following the global rates rise, traders said. Gold gained Rs2000 and Rs1714, reaching Rs284, 300 per tola and Rs243, 741 per 10 grams, respectively, All Sindh Saraf Jewellers Association said.

NEW YORK: Gold prices edged up on Friday after recovering from a profit-taking bout as Middle East tensions and US election jitters supported prices, while palladium prices extended gains to 10-month highs. Spot gold was up 0.2% at \$2,741.50 per ounce by 01:44 p.m. ET (1744 GMT).

Spot rate sheds Rs200 per maund

The Spot Rate Committee of the KCA on Saturday decreased the spot rate by Rs 200 per maund and closed it at Rs 17,600 per maund. Cotton Analyst Naseem Usman told Business Recorder that the local cotton market remained bearish and the trading volume remained satisfactory.

Trade deficit with regional states balloons 62pc
