IMF sees global growth below 3pc in 2023

WASHINGTON: The International Monetary Fund expects global economic growth to dip below 3% in 2023 and to remain around 3% for the next five years, IMF Managing Director Kristalina Georgieva said in prepared remarks on Thursday.

BEIJING: Pakistan had been a long-time supporter of China's efforts to expand the use of the Renminbi (RMB) as a global currency, said Minister of Planning, Development and Special Initiatives, Prof. Ahsan Igbal.

Forex reserves fall by \$56m

KARACHI: The country's liquid foreign exchange reserves fell by \$56 million during the last week due to debt payment. According to the State Bank of Pakistan's weekly foreign exchange reserve report issued Thursday, the total liquid forex reserves held by the country stood at \$9.76 billion as of Mar 31, 2023 compared to \$9.816 billion on March 24, 2023.

THE RUPEE: PKR makes significant gains

KARACHI: Reports of expected inflows from Saudi Arabia helped the Pakistani rupee register significant gains against the US dollar as the currency climbed 1.21% in the inter-bank market on Thursday. As per the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP), the rupee closed at 284.42, an increase of Rs3.43.

Cotton spot rate goes up by Rs300 per maund

LAHORE: The Spot Rate Committee of the Karachi Cotton Association (KCA) on Thursday increased the spot rate by Rs 3,00 per maund and closed it at Rs 19,300 per maund.

Saudi Arabia gives financing pledge vital for reviving IMF deal: Aisha

ISLAMABAD: The government on Thursday said that Saudi Arabia had conveyed its commitment to the International Monetary Fund (IMF) for its bilateral financial support to Pakistan and hoped similar assurance from the United Arab Emirates or some other source would lead to the much-delayed staff-level agreement (SLA) with the Fund and unlock multilateral disbursements.

Global growth seen slipping below 3pc

WASHINGTON: The International Monetary Fund expects global economic growth to dip below three per cent in 2023 and to remain at around 3pc for the next five years, Managing Director Kristalina Georgieva said on Thursday, flagging increased downside risks.

Rupee stages spectacular rally against US dollar

KARACHI: The record-breaking devaluation of the rupee finally halted as the dollar lost Rs3.4 in the interbank market on Thursday after a reported assurance from the Saudi government to provide \$2 billion for deposits.

SBP reserves dip

KARACHI: Foreign exchange reserves held by the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) fell by \$36 million to \$4.20 billion during the week ending on March 31, announced the central bank on Thursday. However, the total liquid foreign reserves of the country declined by \$56m to \$9.8bn while central banks' holdings dipped by \$20m to \$5.6bn during the week.

Constitution provides for zero-loadshedding of gas in Sindh, CM tells federal govt

KARACHI: Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah has told the federal government that the persisting gas shortage in Sindh had not only badly affected the industrial sector, but its loadshedding, even during Ramazan, is also piling miseries on domestic consumers in the province, which produces over 62pc of the country's gas.
